#### **14/22 Minutes:**

# 14/23 Chairman's Report:

a) The Parish Council had received a letter from the Secretary of Richards Castle Village Hall Committee asking if a parish council representative wish to join the Management Committee.

The Parish Council thanked the Committee for asking the Parish Council for a nominee however Councillors were happy with the current make up of representatives on the Management Committee.

b) The Parish Council wished to place on record the work undertaken by Peter Moss in undertaking the winding of the Memorial Clock at Richards Castle Church from which he was retiring and agreed to make a donation of £20 towards a joint thank-you gift with the Parochial Church Council for his many year's service.

## 14/24 Highway Items/Amenity Items/Footpath items:

a) Cllr. A. Wright had attended a meeting with the Highway Agency together with representatives from Brimfield and Orleton Parish Councils to discuss improvements to the A49 Junctions near the Salwey Alms. Although the Highways ruled out the provision of a roundabout they would seek to widen the roadway to improve visibility and the waiting of cars to turn at the junctions and in addition would look to improve signage. The Highway Agency would produce plans for further consultation.

b) Shropshire Council had agreed to meet representatives of the Parish Council to look at improvements to the junction at Park Lane with the A49.

# **14/25 Planning:**
